MARY VIRGINIA CRITES HANNAN PARK

When – Saturday May 19 at 9:00 a.m.

Where – Meet at Shelter House #2 near the woods

What to bring – Binoculars and a bird guide book (some will be available for participant use)

Melanie Shuter and Paul Hang, both Ohio Certified Volunteer Naturalists, will lead a hike to discover some of the birds that inhabit the various habitats at Mary Virginia Crites Hannan Park. Beginners are welcome. We will go over how to fine focus binoculars and get them “on the bird.” Learn how to listen for bird songs and identify birds using their field marks.

All ages are welcome. Children ages 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Use the Starkey Pavilion parking lot accessed from Pontius Road. Come rain or shine. The program will last about 2 hours.
